THE ART INSTITUTE

Ages 14–19 • Two sessions: July 1 – July 19 • July 22 – August 9

The summer sessions of The Art Institute are for motivated artistically and career-minded teens to develop their creativity, build skills in the visual arts, and prepare portfolios for college. Students work with professional artists who serve as teachers and mentors. Located in the Fine Arts Studios and Photo Lab at Dutchess Community College. There are two sessions offered: June 24 – July 12 & July 15 – August 2.



Students choose from four areas of concentration: Advanced Drawing & Painting, Drawing & Painting, Photography and Filmmaking.

Advanced Drawing & Painting

Drawing & Painting

An accelerated foundation course which explores the principles and skills of observation, value, color, and 2D design. This course prepares students for advanced study and portfolio development.

This innovative program is for mid-level students to focus on developing their skills in drawing, painting, photography and filmmaking while helping them prepare for intensive visual arts instruction in high school and beyond. Held in the studios of Dutchess Community College along with its sister program The Art Institute, students will explore the foundations of good artmaking practices in a variety of media. Film & Photography studies will build students' understanding of storytelling, conceptualism, and digital equipment while Drawing & Painting studies will expand their understanding of composition, color relationships, visual art techniques and more.
